Vintage Guide – Red Bordeaux

- 2005 The vintage of a lifetime?
- 2003 A classic vintage, especially in the Medoc. Those that controlled the heat made great wines.
- 2002 An early drinking vintage of high quality where the northern Medoc fared particularly well.
- 2001 A classical, elegant vintage which will age very well.
- 2000 A truly great vintage that can be consumed when young but will keep well. The best year since 1990.
- 1998 An excellent year which produced some quite satisfactory wines. Long lasting wines particularly St Emilion and Pomerol. The Medoc also flourished.
- 1997 These are charming wines, full of ripe, soft fragrant fruit. Few are long keepers, but rather like the 1992 vintage in Burgundy, will provide consistent drinking pleasure.
- 1996 A great vintage on both sides of the river. Enormously structured, with great concentration.
- 1995 A marvellous vintage, one of the best in the 1990's. While the great wines require years of cellaring, others are drinking extremely well now. Forward ripe fruit and classically balanced tannins.
